The Tyendinaga Police Services have requested a Mohawk Council Resolution to prohibit Denis Matthew Murphy on the Tyendinaga Mohawk Territory.

MOTION #1: Moved by Debra A. Vincent, seconded by Josh Hill WHEREAS:

The Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte Band Council has been informed

by Tyendinaga Police Service that the following person:

Denis Matthew MURPHY (DOB: 1964-04-28), Presents a demonstrated threat to the peace, security and health of the

residents of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte:

AND WHEREAS: Denis Matthew MURPHY (DOB: 1964-04-28) has an extensive criminal record that consists of approximately 37 independent convictions for Fraudulent acts. As well, he has convictions for Resist Peace Officer, Driving Offences, and Fail to Comply with Probation. Denis Matthew MURPHY has spent a great deal of time in Detention Centre custody, and is not a member of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte nor is he of indigenous decent.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That Mr. Denis Matthew MURPHY (DOB: 1964-04-28) be prohibited from being on the Territory of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte for any reason.
