The Tyendinaga Police Services have requested a Mohawk Council Resolution to prohibit Peter John Topping on the Tyendinaga Mohawk Territory.

MOTION #1: Moved by Carl E. (Ted) Maracle, seconded by Stacia L. Loft that
WHEREAS: the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council has been informed by Police Chief Jason Brant of the Tyendinaga Police Service that the following person;

Peter John TOPPING DOB: 1962-04-30

Presents a demonstrated threat to the peace, security and health of the residents of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte:

AND WHEREAS: **Peter John TOPPING DOB: 1962-04-30** has an extensive police history which includes Violence, and 33 incidents of negative police contact in the past 3 years alone. TOPPING is not a member of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte nor is he of indigenous heritage. TOPPING is known to frequent 2139 York Road and police have information that he is taking advantage of an elderly male there. As he is wanted by the Napanee OPP

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That Mr. **Peter John TOPPING DOB: 1962/04/30** be prohibited from being on the Territory of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte.
