A special meeting of the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council was held on Tuesday, May 28, 2013 at 1:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers to address administrative issues.

MOTION #1: Moved by Barry Brant, seconded by Douglas E. Maracle that WHEREAS the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council understands the need to evaluate the effectiveness of the environmental practices currently in place at the Public Works Garage and to monitor for potential water quality impacts to ensure that there are no negative impacts to the community health or the surrounding environment;

WHEREAS the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council understands the importance of ensuring that the community health and environment is a high priority for the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte;

WHEREAS the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte are eligible for funding under AANDC's Lands and Environmental Action Fund to complete a monitoring program for the 2013-14 fiscal year at the Public Works Garage located at 38 Lower Slash Road;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council supports the grant application to Lands and Environmental Action Fund in the amount of \$10,426.00 to perform a monitoring program for the 2013-14 fiscal year at the Public Works Garage located at 38 Lower Slash Road.
