FNIGC maintains accountability to First Nations through its membership, which includes all participating Regional Organizations; and

WHEREAS, in its conduct and stewardship over the First Nations Regional Health Survey (RHS), the FNIGC, working together with the Regions, has an established reputation and infrastructure that maintains direct accountability to First Nations leadership, respect for First Nations' principles of OCAP, while providing a security and privacy framework that meets the highest standards; and

WHEREAS, similar to the Regional Health Survey, the FNRECES was developed to respect and uphold rights of First Nations and the jurisdiction of their representative bodies, and to gather First Nations data to be used by First Nations to improve the quality of life of their citizens, communities, and tribal and regional entities; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte Chief and Council consents to the participation of the Tyendinaga First Nation in the First Nations Regional Education, Employment and Early Childhood Development Survey (FNRECES) and the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte Chief and Council acknowledges that, the Chiefs of Ontario has been mandated by the Chiefs in Assembly to conduct this research project.
