A special meeting of the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council was held on Monday, July 6, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers.

MBQ/HPELF has access to a number of contributions. The MCYS share for the MBQ/HPELF partnership program is \$87,400.00 annually with a one time amount of \$10,000.00 for start up costs.

The program administered at the Community Wellbeing Centre have identified \$38,000.00 for the partnership program and the HPELF identified a financial contribution of \$5,000.00 - \$10,000.00.

Kelly Bruce will forward the draft agreements to Council for approval.
