**Further be it Resolved** that Council understand and support as part of the program requirements that a 23 cents per cubic metre surcharge is levied upon the users connected to the proposed newly installed extensions by the natural gas distributor for a duration up to 40 years to assist with the cost of extending natural gas pipelines within the community. Council acknowledges with the surcharge there is still significant energy savings to the community for our heating needs and that a copy of this Band Council Resolution is forwarded to Union Gas in support of the application to Ontario's Natural Gas Grant Program.
