

**TYENDINAGA MOHAWK COUNCIL MINUTES  
MAY 12, 2017**

A special meeting of the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council was held on Friday, May 12, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers to discuss current flooding in low lying areas along the Bay of Quinte.

MOTION #1: Moved by Debra A. Vincent, seconded by Carl E. (Ted) Maracle that the Chief Administrative Officer, David Souliere, be authorized to speak to the media regarding the state of emergency, approved by Chief and Council on May 11, 2017, in the event Chief Maracle is attending other meetings.

MOTION #2: Moved by Douglas E. Maracle, seconded by Carl E. (Ted) Maracle that the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council directs the Chief Administrative Officer, David Souliere, to ensure casual employees engaged to assist in flood relief operations be covered by MBQ Insurance Workers Compensation Benefits.

MOTION #3: Moved by Douglas E. Maracle, seconded by Carl E. (Ted) Maracle that the Chief Administrative Officer, David Souliere, ensure that MBQ staff circulate information to residents regarding drinking water safety and electrical safety during this time of flooding.  
Carried.

David Souliere will contract with a trained casual worker to conduct well water testing in flooded areas and shore wells.

At 2:00 p.m. this afternoon, the MBQ Emergency Control Group will meet in the Council Chambers.

At 3:00 p.m. there will be a telephone call with Environment Canada and Emergency Measures Ontario and other government and municipal officers.
