SEPTEMBER 28, 2021**

A meeting of the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council was held on Tuesday, September 28, 2021.

MOTION #1: Moved by Josh Hill, seconded by Lynda Leween that
WHEREAS: The Tyendinaga Mohawk Council has been informed by the Tyendinaga Police Service that the following person:

Kevin BAILEY DOB: 1981/02/16

Presents a demonstrated threat to the peace, security and health of the residents of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte:

AND WHEREAS: **Kevin BAILEY DOB: 1981/02/16**, is currently residing at 120 Highway #49, Tyendinaga Mohawk Territory, has a violent criminal history, victimizing vulnerable people, exhibits an inability to comply with court orders, and is not a member of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte nor is there evidence he is of indigenous descent.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That **Kevin BAILEY DOB: 1981/02/16**, be prohibited from being on the Tyendinaga Mohawk Territory of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte for any reason. M.C.R. #2021/22-045.

WHEREAS: The Tyendinaga Mohawk Council has been informed by the Tyendinaga Police Service that the following person:

Kevin MADDEN DOB: 1987/02/01

Presents a demonstrated threat to the peace, security and health of the residents of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte:

AND WHEREAS: **Kevin MADDEN DOB: 1987/02/01**, is presently a Correctional Services of Canada inmate attempting to acquire approval to attend Tyendinaga Mohawk Territory, has a serious violent criminal history and is not a member of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte nor is there evidence he is of indigenous descent.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That **Kevin MADDEN DOB: 1987/02/01**, be prohibited from being on the Tyendinaga Mohawk Territory of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte for any reason. M.C.R. #2021/22-046.
