Closing date for all applications is Friday, September 9, 1983, 4 p.m. This position will begin on or about the 19th of September, 1983 and run through March 31, 1984 (28 full weeks). Training allowance is \$250.00. This job is ONLY A TRAINING POSITION and future full time employment will depend on funding sources after March of 1984.
