HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES

The Homemakers program was originally started to aid those who required medical transportation, in-home care and some light housekeeping duties.

At present, this office employs two persons to help assist those who for medical reasons cannot assist themselves. They are Joan Barnhart and Carol John.

It is the intent of this office to provide as much assistance as possible to those in need. However, due to fiscal restraints and cutbacks by the federal government, this office will be forced to keep a careful watch on the work loads of our homemakers who already have many cases.

We will continue to provide as much homemaker services as possible to meet the needs of our community. However, we will need a bit more co-operation from those who are receiving home care or those who may need this service.

Our homemakers require advance notice on doctor, dentist and hospital appointments; at least two days notice is necessary. This can be done by phoning either homemaker (Joan, 962-5889 - Carol, 968-9066).

In addition, homemakers can provide support in the area of grocery shopping; if this service can be provided when a trip has to be made for medical appointments. There will be NO TRIPS as of January, made specifically for grocery shopping.

Our funds and homemakers are very limited, so all assistance must be in relationship to medical reasons if all are to benefit from this service.

Any new persons requiring assistance in this area must phone myself at the Band Office, 396-3424 before contacting a homemaker.

Dental and Optical Coverage

As per agreement the Band covers these services to Band members, however there have been some instances where Band members have taken it upon themselves to secure and pay their services themselves and then seek reimbursement.

This is not possible, as the governmental agencies are seldom in the practice of reimbursing these costs.

Therefore, it is important that forms for glasses are secured from the Band Office, from Carolyn or myself. In order to receive these forms and coverage you must have your eyeglass prescription. As well, if there are any questions about dental (e.g. whether or not your dentist has forms etc), please do not hesitate to secure information from this office. If you feel that your dentist does not have the proper forms, you can secure these from the office.
