STAFF REQUIRED

QUINTE MOHAWK SCHOOL requires the following staff for the school year 1981-1982.

1. SPECIAL EDUCATION RESOURCE CO-ORDINATOR: FULL TIME

The successful candidate will be involved in developing and implementing a well funded and resourced Special Education Pilot Project. The purpose of the project is to develop Procedures for the diagnosis, prevention and remediation of the learning exceptionalities of Amerindian children. Involvement of a team of pediatricians, psychologists, educational consultants, human communications experts as well as others means that the project has unlimited potential for meaningful action and results.

The successful candidate, if it is desired may enter a "loan arrangement" with this school that will enable them to remain employees of their present board for the duration of the Pilot Project, with no loss of seniority or benefits.

This promises to be a very exciting position.

2. GRADE 6: FULL TIME

The successful candidate will have regular classroom duties and also have the opportunity to be involved with a very successful and extensive physical education programme. Salary is paid according to the Federal pay grid, which is above the County's grid at the moment. The teacher engaged will be an employee of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte.

3. GRADE 5: FULL TIME

The successful candidate will have regular classroom duties. Qualifications in Music would be an asset but are not essential. The teacher engaged will be an employee of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte.
