Notice of Amendments to Schedule K **Quinte Mohawk**

A motion to correct the period of eligibility for Quinte Mohawk Day School in Ontario has been approved by the Federal Court.

The periods of eligibility for Quinte Mohawk Day School are now:

(added) September 1, 1955, to August 31, 1960
September 1, 1960, to September 1, 1997

Notice of this change will be communicated to potentially impacted Survivor Class Members and Band Councils within the community.

Class Members, who have already filed a Claim Form, and who may be impacted by this change, will be contacted directly by the Claims Administrator.

Individuals eligible to submit a claim for compensation as a result of this change are encouraged to submit their Claim Form by July 13, 2022. For those who miss this deadline, applications for a 6-month extension to the deadline (to January 13, 2023) due to this change are anticipated to be granted by the Exceptions Committee. Individuals who file a Claim Form, and who have attended Quinte Mohawk during the updated eligibility period, will be giving up their right to sue Canada for harms/abuses experienced during that time.
