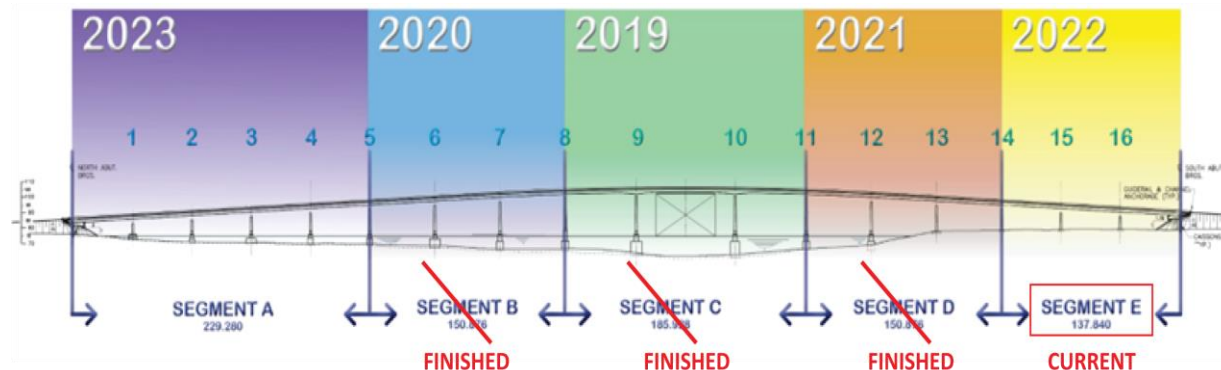

Public Notification – **Full Mainline Night Closures (Updated)**

To Whom It May Concern,

This letter is to notify you that there will be a **Full Mainline Night Closure** of Highway 49 at the Bay of Quinte Skyway Bridge from **9:00 PM on Tuesday, January 10, 2023 to 6:00 AM on Wednesday, January 11, 2023**. This closure is intended for the epoxy injection of the South Abutment Expansion Joint, which requires a full closure to complete the work across the entire width of the bridge.

In addition, a **Full Mainline Night Closure** is also scheduled from **9:00 PM on Thursday, January 12, 2023 to 6:00 AM on Friday, January 13, 2023**. This closure is intended for the implementation of Stage 3A configuration for Segment E work, which will consist of relocating temporary concrete barriers, temporary energy attenuators, placing temporary pavement markings, and placing traffic on the west side of the bridge.

Please note that the Full Mainline Night Closures previously scheduled for Tuesday, January 3, 2023 and Thursday, January 5, 2023 from 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM are now cancelled.



During these time periods the highway will be closed, and no traffic will be permitted to pass over the bridge. Please refer to the following website for the Glenora Ferry as an alternative route:
