

Notice of Public Consultation on the Issuance of a New Long-Term Care Home Licence for Mohawks Bay of Quinte to be located in Deseronto, Ontario

The Ministry of Long-Term Care (MLTC) is reviewing a proposal from Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte Representated by Tyendinaga Mohawk Council (the Proposed Licensee) for issuing a long-term care (LTC) home licence for Mohawks Bay of Quinte (the Home), a new 128-bed LTC home proposed to be developed at 301 Bayshore Road in Deseronto, Ontario.

The proposal involves:

- the development of 128 LTC beds subject to meeting all licensing requirements under the Fixing Long-Term Care Act, 2021 (the “FLTCA”); and
- the approval and issuance of a new licence with a term of up to 30 years for the operation of 128 “New” beds, following the development of the Home.
