

**TYENDINAGA MOHAWK COUNCIL MINUTES
JUNE 28, 2023**

A meeting of the Tyendinaga Mohawk Council was held on Wednesday, June 28, 2023 at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers for Local Business.

Council discussed the Business Registrations for gas stations. Councillor Chris Maracle asked if the owners need to provide proof of insurance when registering the business.

Council reviewed the DMAF application for servicing the remaining un-serviced roads on the territory. Community Infrastructure requires a Mohawk Council Resolution for this application.

MOTION #6: Moved by Chris Maracle, seconded by Carl E. (Ted) Maracle that
WHEREAS, the Tyendinaga Mohawk Territory has experienced
annual droughts in five of the last seven years; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 Climate Change Adaptation Plan recommended
maximizing the capacity of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte
centralized water treatment plant and extend water distribution mains
to increase access to a dependable water supply throughout the
community; and

WHEREAS, there are approximately 24kms of un-serviced roads
remaining upon completion of phases 1-4 under the Disaster
Mitigation Fund this fall,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tyendinaga Mohawk
Council approves to submit an application in the amount of
\$56,430,000 to the Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund to extend
watermain distribution servicing to the remaining homes vulnerable to
drought conditions as a result of climate change.
