Mitigation Fund this fall,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tyendinaga Mohawk

Council approves to submit an application in the amount of \$56,430,000 to the Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund to extend

\$56,430,000 to the Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund to extend watermain distribution servicing to the remaining homes vulnerable to

drought conditions as a result of climate change.
