

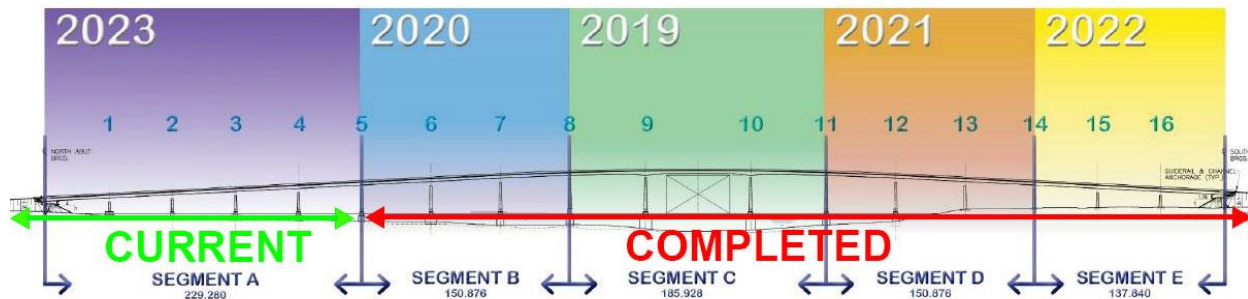

Public Notification – **Full Mainline Night Closures**

To Whom It May Concern,

This letter is to notify you that **the Full Mainline Night Closures previously scheduled for Thursday August 17, 2023 with a backup date of August 21, 2023 from 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM are now cancelled due to ongoing poor weather conditions.** There will be a **Full Mainline Night Closure** of Highway 49 at the Bay of Quinte Skyway Bridge from **9:00 PM on Thursday, August 24, 2023 to 6:00 AM on Friday, August 25, 2023.** In case of continued poor weather conditions during the upcoming weeks, the closure may be rescheduled to take place from **9:00 PM on Monday, August 28, 2023 to 6:00 AM on Tuesday, August 29, 2023.**

This closure is intended for the implementation of staging configuration for Segment A Stage 2 work, which will consist of relocating temporary concrete barriers, temporary energy attenuators, placing temporary pavement markings, and flipping traffic to the east side of the bridge.



During these time periods the highway will be closed, and no traffic will be permitted to pass over the bridge. Please refer to the following website for the Glenora Ferry as an alternative route:
