

## **Road Construction Notice**

## September 12, 2023 - September 29, 2023

The 2023 Tar and Chip program includes work on the following roads:

- Homeland Dr, Lower Slash Rd, Bells Rd,
- Upper Slash Rd, Marks Rd, Beach Rd, Ridge Rd (All Saints Church to Norway's Rd)
- Cedar Glenn Rd, Gussy's Lane

Pulverizing is scheduled for September 11, 2023. Dust and loose gravel are expected during the application but will begin to subside when the base coat cures properly.

Tar and Chip is scheduled to begin the week of September 11, 2023. The affected roads will be closed during the installation of tar and chip. Homeowners may have temporary restrictions to their laneways during the installation.

The possibility of dust and loose gravel may occur immediately after installation. It's typical for dust and loose stones to appear but this will diminish with time and use. Avoid turning vehicle wheels while stationary, making sharp turns, or performing any actions that may damage the surface, to allow the tar and chip surface time to cure properly.
