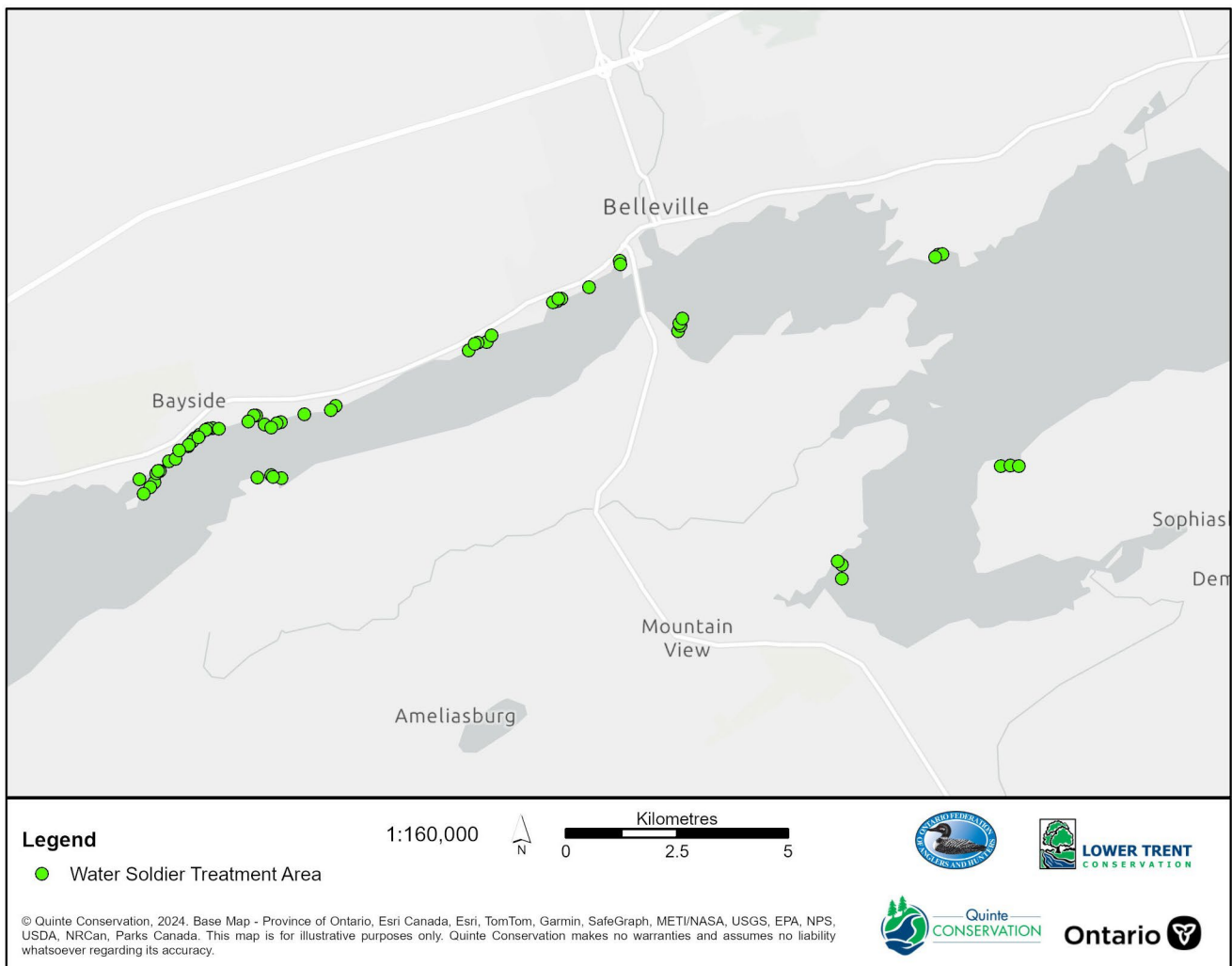


Water Soldier Control Notice



An aquatic herbicide application is scheduled for the control of the highly invasive plant water soldier in parts of the Bay of Quinte in Quinte West, Belleville, and Prince Edward County.

Shoreline residents immediately adjacent to specific treatment locations will receive direct notification prior to treatment.

Dates: September 24 - 26, 2024 (weather permitting)

Herbicide: Reward® (Diquat dibromide)

The water-use restrictions on the product label for Reward® Aquatic Herbicide are:

- ***Do not use treated water for at least 24 hours after treatment for swimming or animal consumption.***
- ***For human consumption and irrigation, do not use water for 5 days after treatment.***
- ***If you draw water for drinking from a treatment area, call Solitude Lake Management at 1-888-480-5253.***

There are no restrictions on fishing or waterfowl hunting in the treatment areas.
