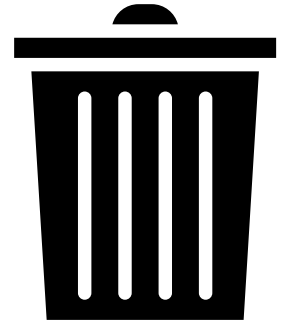




MBQ Curbside Garbage Program



MBQ cares about your garbage, you should too!
Here are some things to remember:

- MBQ requires **bag tags** be attached and visible on **all** garbage bags
- Waste & recycle must go out by **8am** on your day of collection
 - the route changes to accommodate emptying the truck, so your collection time will not be consistent
- The crew cannot cross the road, **Do Not** put your waste or recycle out after you've seen the crew go by
- Trash should not weigh more than **50lbs** and should not include hazardous material, carcasses, furniture, scrap metal or construction material.
- Note that using the MBQ **recycling program** will be reduce the amount of garbage you produce

The curbside program has implemented a stickering process when there is an issue with your waste or recycle! It is your responsibility to check the sticker placed on your non-collected waste or recycle and correct the issue for the following week. Do not leave bags curbside without having first corrected your mistake!

west route: **Tuesday**
