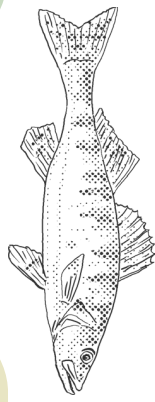
Skakahráksen (walleye) harvest season is upon us!

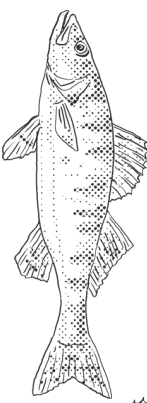


During the season, keep an eye out for our Walleye Harvest Managers who will be offering traditional knowledge, and milking assistance where needed!

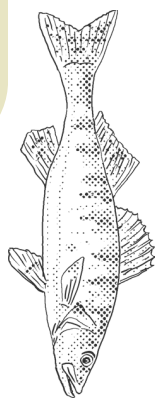

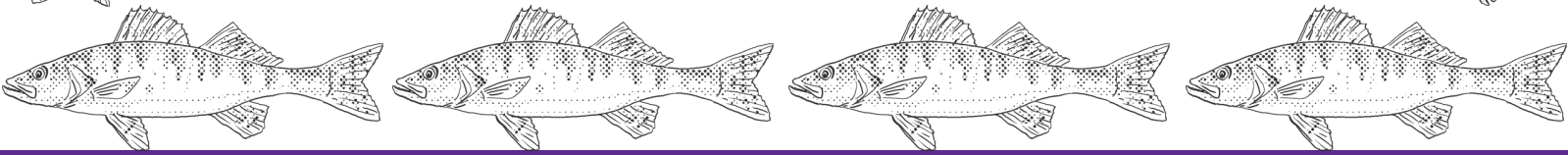
