



CULBERTSON TRACT PER CAPITA DISTRIBUTION UPDATE

The Tyendinaga Mohawk Council would like to clarify eligibility requirements for the Culbertson Tract Per Capita Distribution.

To be eligible for the one-time per capita distribution, an individual must have been a registered member of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte, or entitled to be a registered member, as of December 17, 2025 (the Entitlement Date).

Individuals are encouraged to begin or complete their registration process with ISC as soon as possible to ensure they meet the requirements prior to the PCD application deadline date of December 16, 2026.

Individuals who are not currently registered but believe they are entitled to be registered must apply directly to Indigenous Services Canada (ISC), as ISC is solely responsible for determining registration and entitlement.

As part of the Culbertson Tract Per Capita Distribution application process, applicants who are not yet registered members must provide proof that a registration application has been submitted to ISC by December 16, 2026.

Per Capita Distribution payments can only be issued to individuals who are confirmed as registered members of the Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte and who met the eligibility criteria as of the Entitlement Date. Payment will not be issued until membership registration has been confirmed by ISC.

To date, MBQ has received over 1,000 PCD applications, and the review and processing phase is underway. Payments are anticipated to begin in April 2026. Please note that processing may take up to three (3) months from when an application is submitted, depending on verification requirements.
