Project Description: The facility is expected to have a maximum generating capacity of 19.2 MW AC and will generate enough clean, renewable electricity to supply thousands of Ontario homes while supporting the province's growing energy needs. The project has been designed using an agrivoltaics approach, allowing agricultural activities to continue alongside renewable energy generation through the use of sheep grazing for vegetation management. As the project progresses, environmental, engineering, and technical studies will be completed to inform the final design and ensure the project is developed responsibly.
